1. Scofieldfarms.org website

The Scofieldfarms.org website is the official online communication channel from the Scofield Residential Owners Association (ROA) to Scofield Farms residents. Here you can find the latest news about current events in the neighborhood, contact information for the ROA board and management company, copies of Scofield Farms-related documents and forms, as well as helpful links from the city of Austin. The website is also the home of the scofieldfarms.org forum.

2. Scofieldfarms.org forum

The scofieldfarms.org forum is a moderated discussion board whose primary focus is the Scofield Residential Owners Association (ROA) and community. Some topics covered on the forum include ROA projects, contractor and professional suggestions, children, pets, security and items for sale. 4. Scofield Farms Instant Communicator

Scofield Farms Instant Communicator is a means of quickly disseminating important news regarding situations currently occurring (such as crimes in progress, suspicious activity, or severe weather warnings) to our community. It involves the sending and receiving of text messages by subscribers through the use of the GroupMe application.
